



First Aid at Work Training Course (3 day) Classroom Based

First Aid at Work Level 3 (VTQ) qualification (FAW) is ideal for most businesses whose risk assessment has identified that they require a fully trained first aider for their workplace. The course meets the requirements of the [First Aid at Work \(First Aid\) regulations 1981](#).

Who should attend?

What you will learn?

The course provides basic lifesaving first aid and workplace health and safety regulations, covering the following:

- Understand the role and responsibilities of a first aider
- Be able to assess an incident
- Be able to provide first aid to an unresponsive casualty
- Be able to provide first aid to a casualty who is choking
- Be able to provide first aid to a casualty with external bleeding
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty who is in shock
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty with minor injuries
- Recognition and Management of Illness and Injury in the Workplace
- Be able to conduct a secondary survey
- Be able to provide first aid to a casualty with suspected injuries to bones, muscles and joints
- Be able to provide first aid to a casualty with suspected head and spinal injuries
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty with suspected chest injury
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty with burns and scolds
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty with an eye injury
- Know how to provide first aid to a casualty with sudden poisoning



Assessment

Continuous observation and assessment by the trainer throughout the course.

Certification

Successful candidates will receive certification, which is valid for three years.

Course size

To ensure every delegate can engage and benefits from participation the course size is limited to a maximum of 12 people. Participants should be physically able to participate in practical activities.

Re-qualification

Once you have completed Emergency First Aid at Work training you will need to attend the 2 day First Aid at Work Requalification to keep up with validation.
